SCHOOL TOUR PROGRAM

THE LUGINBILL FARM HOUSE W/GARDEN AND ORCHARD, 1857

Find out what farm life was like for children in the 1800s. Boys may carry in wood and water while the girls might learn about wood range cooking, laundry or cleaning lamps. "Mrs. Luginbill" or one of her farm helpers will also talk about the home's unique wattle and daub architecture, morning and evening chores, what housekeeping was like, and yes—even emptying chamber pots!

THE YAGER SCHOOL HOUSE, 1881

Children will participate in the opening exercises mandated for all Adams County Schools at the turn of the last century. They'll take the required "pledge" to be good, attend regularly, and study hard. The school marm will explain the word "discipline" and how we abide by the rules and/or their consequences.

THE WITTE PIONEER LOG CABIN, 1839

Children will learn what life was like for pioneer children in Adams County. They will find out how hard young folks had to work and about the dangers of the deep woods and swamps that were abundant. They will experience the isolation of pioneers at the 1839 Witte Log Cabin, which is in the Swiss Heritage Woods.

PLAY GAMES

Students will spend approximately 20 minutes at each historical site. Between locations, students are invited to try games from the 19th century.
